Public Hearing: Amendments to portions of Clark County Stormwater Code and Stormwater Manual

The Council will consider the adoption of updates to the Clark County Stormwater Code and Stormwater Manual as required under Clark County's Phase I Municipal Stormwater Permit through the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) program. The NPDES permit requires updates to both the manual and county code to reflect mandatory changes. Additional revisions are to clarify existing language, correct errors, incorporate feedback from manual users, and maintain alignment with the state manual.
