PUBLIC HEARING: PREFERRED LAND USE ALTERNATIVE

The Council will consider the following:

Preferred Land Use Alternative for the 2025-2045 Comprehensive Plan Update: Clark County is in the process of updating the 2016 Comprehensive Growth Management Plan (Comprehensive Plan). In addition, the cities of Battle Ground, Camas, La Center, Ridgefield, Washougal, Woodland, and Yacolt are also updating their comprehensive plans.

Three land use alternatives were studied for those cities and the county in a draft environmental impact statement (DEIS) that was the subject of a 60-day review and public comment period which ended on Nov. 30, 2025. The City of Vancouver is also updating its Comprehensive Plan and is preparing separate environmental documentation for its plan update.

The purpose of the hearing will be to take public testimony on the Planning Commission recommendation on the preferred land use alternative and select a preferred land use alternative. A final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS) will be prepared on the selected alternative.
